ABOUT CEREBRAL PALSY

Cerebral palsy (CP) is a neurological condition that occurs during pregnancy, labor or after birth, damaging the central nervous system. CP affects 500,000 to 800,000 Americans with another 5,800 babies born with CP each year. It is the goal of Pedal-with-Pete to raise money for medical research to treat or reverse the effects of CP.

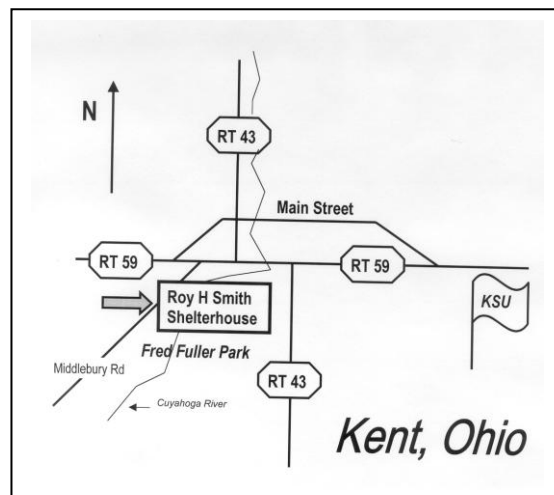

BIKE registration and start/finish line will be at Fred Fuller Park in Kent. The 15-mile route travels on the Hike and Bike Trail, continues through the towns of Silver Lake, and Stow. The 40-mile route heads through Kent, north through neighborhoods to Streetsboro and into Hudson, continuing on to the Boston Heights area where it picks up the Bike/Hike Trail, through Stow, Silver Lake, Munroe Falls, and back to Kent. The 60-mile route is on back roads that will travel through Brimfield, Ravenna Township and Kent. Light refreshments and water will be available at rest areas along all routes.

HIKE starts at Fred Fuller Park with a walk along the Cuyahoga River. A barrier-free alternate walk is available.

Fred Fuller Park is located at 497 Middlebury Road off Route 59 on the west side of Kent.
